



The Minitrusts Program for Benefactors



Do you have a friend or family member who is homeless (or at risk of being homeless) whom you would like to help if you wouldn't have to hand them the cash?

A **Minitrust** is a bonded nonprofit account into which you contribute, and from which are paid vendors of products or services that your homeless father, son, mother, brother, or friend needs. This can range from a bus pass to an apartment's rent.

Although being clean and sober is recommended, it is not a requirement for this **Minitrusts Program**. The only requirement is that the beneficiary be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless

How to Start
