



The Minitrusts Program for the Homeless



Do you have a friend or family member who would help you if they wouldn't have to hand you the cash?

A **Minitrust** is a bonded nonprofit account into which your father, son, mother, brother, friend, etc can contribute, and from which are paid vendors of products or services that you need. This can range from a bus pass to an apartment's rent.

Although being clean and sober is recommended, it is not a requirement for this **Minitrusts Program**. The only requirement is that you be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

How to Start

- 1) Go to our website at www.Minitrusts.org to learn more about the program.
- 2) Get hold of us with your questions, most commonly with email at info@minitrusts.org. If you don't have an email address, go to your neighborhood library and ask them how to set up and check an mailbox at gmail.com. This is free.
- 3) Either get hold of your friend or relative, or we can do it for you if you provide their contact info.
- 4) Tell them about this **Minitrusts Program**, and ask them if they would like to participate.
- 5) If they would like to try it, our website has a simple application form and a video about how to fill it in. Plus, we have human Coordinators who would be happy to help them and you to get started.
